




Welcome Back CMMES!

Terrie Monte Secretary

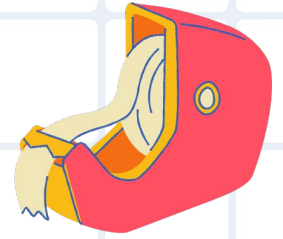
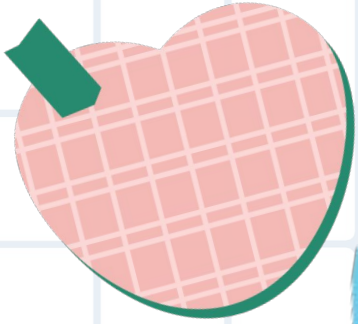
Mrs. Terrie is our school secretary. She handles all of our fundraisers, PTO interactions, registration and bookkeeping.

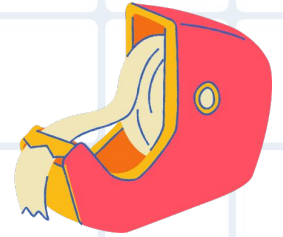
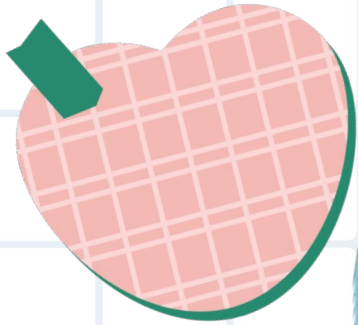

Regular School Hours and Extended Care

School begins taking in at 7:25am. Breakfast ends at 7:50. Students who arrive after 7:55am will be marked tardy.

Dismissal begins at 3:10pm. The latest a parent can check a student out of school is 2:50 pm. This will be strictly enforced.

Our school offers a before school and afterschool program. Details for our extended care program can be found on our website (This is a recent change as we were supposed to transition into REACH aftercare. We are no longer doing that, so If you are interested in school aftercare, it is on a first come first serve basis. Once we are at capacity, we do not take any more students.
