Our School Improvement Plan

2022-2023 School Improvement Goals and Priorities

Given the data we've shared, **Alice Boucher Elementary** is focused on the following priorities for the 2022-2023 school year:

- **3-5 MATH GOAL:**
 - By the end of the year, **43.2%** of students will maintain or obtain an achievement level of basic or higher.
- **3-5 ELA GOAL:**
 - By the end of the year, **58.7%** of students will maintain or obtain an achievement level of basic or higher.
- **K-2 ELA GOAL:**
 - K: By the end of the year, **65%** of students will obtain/maintain an achievement level of Benchmark or Advanced in the Composite on DIBELS.
 - 1- By the end of the year, **70%** of students will obtain/maintain an achievement level of Benchmark or Advanced in the Composite on DIBELS.
 - 2-By the end of the year, **75%** of students will obtain/maintain an achievement level of Benchmark or Advanced in the Composite on DIBELS.
- **Behavior GOAL:**
 - By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, out of school suspension rate will decrease from **18.2%** to **15.6%**.
