The School Board of the Parish of Lafayette, State of Louisiana, met in special session at its regular meeting place, the Lafayette Parish School Board Administrative Building, Board Room, Lafayette, Louisiana, on Wednesday, April 26, 2000 at 5:00 P. Wilson informed the Board that the meeting had been called for the purpose of hearing an expulsion case.

CASE #TSC

The Chair asked the party involved if they wanted an open or a close session. The party requested that the hearing be held in open session.

After hearing the expulsion case, it was moved by Hardy that the Board go in executive session to read a letter he had received from a parent. Motion died for lack of a second.

Motion (Cox, Hefner) that the Board uphold staff's recommendation that Case #TSC not be allowed to return to Acadiana High for the remainder of the 1999-2000 school year and that he be allowed to apply to the C.A.P.S. Program for the remainder of the school year.

A substitute motion was made by Hardy that Case #TSC be reinstated at Acadiana High School. Motion died for lack of a second.

The Chair called for a vote on the original motion. Motion carried. Hardy requested that he be recorded as voting NO.

CASE #WM

Case #WM was cancelled at the request of the parent.
