The School Board of the Parish of Lafayette, State of Louisiana, met in special session at its regular meeting place, the Lafayette Parish School Board Administrative Building, Board Room, Lafayette, Louisiana, on Wednesday, May 3, 2000 at 9:00 A. M. pursuant to notice given in writing to every member.

The President, called the meeting to order.

I. LEVEL V GRIEVANCE CASE ALFRIEDA MASON

The Chair asked the party involved if they wanted an open or a close session. The party requested that the hearing be held in open session.

After some discussion, the Chair called for a recess.

The Chair reconvened the meeting.

Motion (Gibson, Sam) that the Board upholds the Superintendent's recommendation regarding the Level V Grievance Case for Alfrieda Mason for reasons that evidence was not provided nor subsequent findings to support the basis of the grievance that she be assigned to a Secretary II position in the Census and Attendance Department and therefore, the relief sought by Alfrieda Mason be denied. Motion carried. Hardy requested that he be recorded as voting NO.

II. LEVEL V GRIEVANCE CASE STEVE JACQUET

The Chair noted that the person filing the Level V Grievance, Steve Jacquet, was not in attendance at 1:22 P. M. for a scheduled 1:00 P. M. meeting.

Motion (Hefner, Gibson) that after reviewing the testaments and documents that had been provided to the Board members regarding the Level V Grievance filed by Steve Jacquet that the Board finds no evidence nor subsequent findings to support the basis of the grievance that he be reinstated as Director of Purchasing, all back pay and that he be reimbursed \$2,000,000 for damages and therefore, the relief sought by Steve Jacquet be denied. Motion carried. Thibodaux was absent.

There being no further business, it was moved by Hefner, seconded by Hardy and carried that the meeting adjourn.
