### **SPECIAL COMMITTEE MEETING ON EXPULSION HEARING(S)**

The Chair informed the Committee that the meeting had been called for the purpose of hearing an expulsion case.

#### **I. CASE #EF**

The Chair asked the party involved if they wanted an open or a closed session. The party requested that the hearing be held in closed session.

Motion (Guidry, Gibson) that the Committee go in closed session to hear the above case. Motion carried.

Motion (Gibson, Hardy) that the Committee reconvene to regular session. Motion carried.

A substitute motion was made by Guidry that the Committee uphold staff's recommendation that Case #EF, 11<sup>th</sup> grade student at Lafayette High School, be expelled for twenty-four (24) calendar months, and be allowed to attend the LAPS Program. Motion died for lack of second.

The Chair called for a roll call vote on the original motion. Voting for were Hardy, Sam, Cox and Gibson. Voting against were Guidry and LaCombe. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
