

## **CORRESPONDENCE STUDY COURSES**

Credit toward high school graduation for high school students shall be earned through correspondence work from Louisiana State University, Southern University or other accredited universities as approved by the Bureau of Secondary Education.

An application to the Office of Independent Study for correspondence study courses shall be approved by the high school principal and the Director of the Bureau of Secondary Education, State Department of Education. This method is the only method by which correspondence study credits acceptable to the State Department of Education may be earned.

In order to be approved to award high school credit for correspondence courses, a university must apply to the Bureau of Secondary Education. The application shall include a detailed course description with objectives for each course offering. Courses will be approved on an individual basis. Required courses must address all standards listed in the appropriate state-approved curricular guides.
