

STUDENT RECOGNITION

A. HONOR ROLL

All 1–8 schools, regardless of grade structure, will adhere to a uniform policy in designating students for honor roll. A student named for honor roll recognition at the end of any grading period must have met the following requirements:

1. A grade point average of 3.0 or better at grade level with no grade lower than a “B”.
2. In other academic subjects, no “N” (Needs Improvement) or “U” (Unsatisfactory) for the grading period where E, S, N or U are used.
3. Conduct grades shall be applicable for consideration for honor roll.

Each school will plan appropriate procedures for recognizing students who meet the requirements given above.

B. SPECIAL RECOGNITION

Each school is encouraged to recognize students who have demonstrated outstanding academic effort/achievement but who are ineligible for honor roll.
