****NOTE FOR FRESHMEN AND THEIR PARENTS:** Parents, please have your child at school by 8 a.m. Give your child the utility bill and the money for fees and/or T-shirts. Students will go to the boys' gym for an introductory meeting. Parents will report to the auditorium for a meeting with the freshmen administrators. When the parent meeting is over, **you will leave and return to pick up your child at 11:30.** Your child will be supervised by our LINK CREW at all times. LINK CREW will do team building exercises with your child, take your child through orientation, and take them on a tour of the campus. Parents, enjoy your free time!!! **The actual orientation process does not begin until after the introductory meeting for freshmen ends at 9 a.m.,** so if you come to orientation without your child, you will not be able to turn in utility bills or pay fees until after 9.

Dress Code: Students are not required to wear a uniform to orientation, but they must wear school-appropriate attire. Yearbook and ID photos will be taken. Students who are absent from orientation will take pictures in school uniform on makeup day.

What To Bring

#1--Current Utility Bill as Proof of Residence

- Must be dated June, July, or August 2017
- Only electric, gas, or water (no cable, phone, garbage, etc.)
- Bring the ENTIRE PRINTED bill
 - No stubs
 - If you participate in paperless billing, you must print out a copy of your most recent bill. We cannot just see the bill on your phone.
- If you recently moved and have not received a utility bill yet, you may contact the utility company to receive proof of residency.
- Make copies, especially if you have more than one child in school (one copy for each child), because we will be keeping your copy and we will not have a copy machine available.
- At the top of the bill, clearly write the child's name, the grade level, the relationship of the person named on the bill (mom, dad, grandfather, etc.), and either IN ZONE or the name of any ACADEMY/SPECIAL PROGRAM the child is in (Gifted, Health Academy, French Immersion, ESL, etc.)

****If you do not bring proof of residence, you will not be able to go to any stations.**



#2--Cash, checks, or money orders for fees (see back)

Schedules: Students will not receive schedules if utility bills are not turned in and fees are not paid.

***All freshmen will receive schedules at the end of orientation from their LINK CREW leaders. However, if freshmen students do not attend orientation and participate in LINK CREW activities (i.e. parent attends in student's place, student arrives late, or student chooses not to join his/her assigned group), their schedules will not be available until freshmen orientation ends at 11:30.*

Schedule Change Requests will be accepted during orientation. Put forms in the box outside counseling office. Schedule change requests will not be accepted after August 8, unless the request is due to an administrative error.

- Please note that counselors may not be available to meet with students and/or parents during orientation.
- The counseling office will be open Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. after July 19th for students/parents to meet with grade-level counselors. For your convenience, schedule change requests will also be accepted by email (see below).
- All students will report to homeroom on the first day of school where they will receive new schedules.



ID/YEARBOOK PICTURES will be taken in room 118 only after all fees are paid. If you do not take your picture at this time, you must wear a school uniform to take your ID/yearbook picture at a later date.

Yearbooks: Yearbook orders must be placed online at www.yearbookordercenter.com. Use School Code #16167 (Yearbooks are \$60 if purchased before Oct. 1; \$70 if purchased after Oct. 1. You may choose to pay \$5 extra to have it shipped directly to you.)
