A. INFORMATION REPORTS

a. Curriculum Update

Patsy Williams, Supervisor, presented an executive summary to the Board regarding the Homeless Education Program. The program provides enrollment and educational assistance to homeless students and case management services to their families. A “homeless” person is defined as one who does not have a fixed, regular, adequate nighttime residence. The program was implemented in October, 1993 and serves homeless children and youth from birth to 21 years old.

b. Kim Perrot, Former Acadiana High School Athlete

Janet Hiatt, Area Director, informed the Board that an award in memory of Kim Perrot will be established at Acadiana High School. Ms. Perrot was an outstanding women's basketball player who went on to play professionally with outstanding career achievements. She was also a caring and compassionate individual who worked within her community for the betterment of others. A female student athlete who demonstrates the same athletic talents and caring and compassionate traits will be honored every year.

c. Use of Inmate Labor in Schools

Kyle Bordelon, Acting Director of Maintenance, informed the Board that a committee had met to discuss issues, experiences and concerns regarding the use of inmate labor on school campuses. The Board Attorney will provide more information at a future Board meeting.

d. Patterson Street Home Ownership

Jonathan Carmouche, Assistant Director of Lafayette Parish Housing Authority, informed the Board that a new housing development is planned next to A. Boucher Elementary School. The first phase of twenty-six duplexes is scheduled for 2008 and will be a one or two bedroom homes for the elderly.

C. RESOLUTION 07-07-1563 – SCHOOL RESOURCES OFFICER'S PROGRAM

That the Board adopt Resolution 07-07-1563 – School Resources Officer's Program.

**RESOLUTION – 07-07-1563**

**WHEREAS**, due to various issues associated with juvenile victimization and delinquency in this community and the Lafayette Parish public schools, interaction and supervision of the students on a daily basis is necessary; and,

**WHEREAS**, as a result of these issues, the School Board has instituted the School Resources Officer's Program (hereinafter referred to as the "SRO Program"), which has been adopted by the Lafayette Police Department, a Department of LCG (hereinafter referred to as the "LPD"), to assist the school system with the zero tolerance program; and,

**WHEREAS**, the SRO Program is one in which post certified police officers interact with teachers and administrators of the Lafayette Parish School System through assigned onsite patrols of school campuses; and,

**WHEREAS**, the SRO Program is based on the nationally recognized triad concept where the School Resource Officer (hereinafter referred to as the "SRO") is a law enforcer, counselor and teacher. Specific training on working in a school environment has been given to the SRO through the National Association of School Resource Officers; and,

**WHEREAS**, the SRO is trained to provide counseling or referrals to anyone in the school community concerning criminal matters. The SRO is assigned to and placed at a particular campus, during the school year, from the time the students arrive on campus until their departure; and,

**WHEREAS**, successfully, for the past two (2) years, the LPD has financed and utilized two (2) officers as SROs; one (1) has been assigned to the N. P. Moss Middle School campus and the other has been assigned to the Northside High School campus. Anti-social behavior and/or inappropriate activity on both campuses has decreased; and,

**WHEREAS**, statistics have shown that anti-social behavior and/or inappropriate activity is on the rise at Lafayette High School and Lafayette Middle School, and thus, the School Board desires to enter into this Intergovernmental Agreement with the LCG (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") to expand the SRO Program by assigning two (2) additional SROs to these two (2) other at-risk schools; and,

**WHEREAS**, the School Board has agreed to assist the LPD with the salaries of the two (2) additional SROs; and,

**WHEREAS**, Article VII, Section 14(C) of the 1974 Constitution of the State of Louisiana, Section 1-07 of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Home Rule Charter and La. R.S. 33:1324, *et seq.*, provide that, for a public purpose, public entities, parishes, municipalities and political subdivisions may engage in and make cooperative endeavor agreements/intergovernmental agreements between themselves for specific purposes; now,

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Lafayette Parish School Board does hereby agree to the intergovernmental agreement by and between the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government for additional School Resource Officers.
