

**LAFAYETTE PARISH SCHOOL BOARD
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING**

The School Board of the Parish of Lafayette, State of Louisiana, met in special session at its regular meeting place, the Lafayette Parish School Board Administrative Building, Board Room, Lafayette, Louisiana, on Tuesday, February 21, 2006 at 4:30 P. M., pursuant to notice given in writing to every member.

The Chair called the meeting to order.

I. RECONSIDERATION OF NON-TEACHER SALARY SCHEDULE REDESIGN

A motion was made by Hardy that the Board approve the technical, support staff, craft and trade, and administrative/professional pay adjustments in a lump sum, and that the increase be paid as a supplement check on March 12, 2006.

The Chair ruled the motion out of order.

Motion (Sam, Guidry) that the Board rescind the motion on administrative/professional salary schedule, and proceed with support staff, technical, and craft and trade pay increases.

A substitute motion was made by Hardy that the Board not rescind or suspend the action taken of February 15, 2006 regarding Non-Teacher Salary Schedule Redesign.

The Chair ruled the substitute motion out of order.

After some discussion, Sam and Guidry withdrew their motion.

Motion (Sam, Hefner) that the Board delay implementation of the four (4) schedules (Administrative/Professional, Technical, Support, and Craft and Trades), and allow staff to rework the schedules and come back to the Board within thirty (30) days with another recommendation.

After some discussion, Hardy called for the question.

The Chair called for a roll call vote on the call for the question. Voting for was Hardy. Voting against were Cox, Gibson, Guidry, Hefner, LaCombe, Sam, and Wilson. Motion failed. Thibodaux was absent.

The Chair called for a roll call vote on the motion made by Sam and Hefner. Voting for were: Cox, Gibson, Guidry, Hefner, LaCombe, Sam, and Wilson. Voting against was Hardy. Motion carried. Thibodaux was absent.

There being no further business, it was moved by Hefner, seconded by Wilson, and carried that the meeting adjourn.
